Tour "making things last longer" is both pructical and patriotic. Here are some suggestions for prolonging the life of the helpful electric servant that save so much time and labor in your house-hold. Novel all these applicances have critical naterials in some part of their construction ... makes, aluminum, nickel, ferromism, copper, alloy seel. When you make appliances last longer by careful use, you are conserving materials vital for the war effort.

(1) After using an appliance, don't disconnect it by pulling on the electric cord. Yanking on the cord electron its life. Always take hold of the plag when disconnecting cord. Don't let cord touch hot appliances.

(2) Never immerse any electric appliance in water.

(3) Do not use a fork to remove toast from a toaster. Remove crumbs from your automatic toaster periodically.

(4) Don't go away and leave your iron turned on-even to answer the phone or doorbell. Don't leave iron cord dangling so that it can be caught accidentally and the iron pulled to the floor.

(5) Do not let large amounts of dirt collect in vacuum cleaner bag.

(6) To protect the electric heating units a switches on appliances, avoid spilling food fluids on them while cooking.

(7) Do not let electric percolators, teakettles, etc. hoil dry. Do not completely drain flem while they are still hot.
