

Civilian Defense Nurses' Corps Addressed by Leaders

War Emergency Work Program is Discussed

Graduate Registered Members of Group Stand Ready For Instant Call at Any Hour of Day or Night

The Civilian Defense Nurses Corps of the Grosse Pointe area held a meeting in the Neighborhood Club on October 28, where it was addressed by Mrs. Helene J. Lang, president and Mrs. Jay M. Albright, secretary.

They were informed in general terms by these officials how the organization had advanced in its preparation for war emergency work since Pearl Harbor. The unit meets frequently for group instruction and

At the meeting the other evening Mrs. Lang said, "few communities can boast of a larger volunteer nursing corps, in proportion to population, than our own. We are confident that the people of this area need not be denied any necessary nursing service that is within our ability to administer."

Since last February, when the call for volunteers went out, 10 graduate, registered nurses have offered their services. Although several have been drafted for active duty with the Army and Red Cross, yet remain available for instant call in the event of an alert at any hour of the day or night.

The nurses serve under the Medical Corps of the Office of Civilian Defense and may be dispatched wherever needed by Dr. Donald Ross, medical chief of the area.

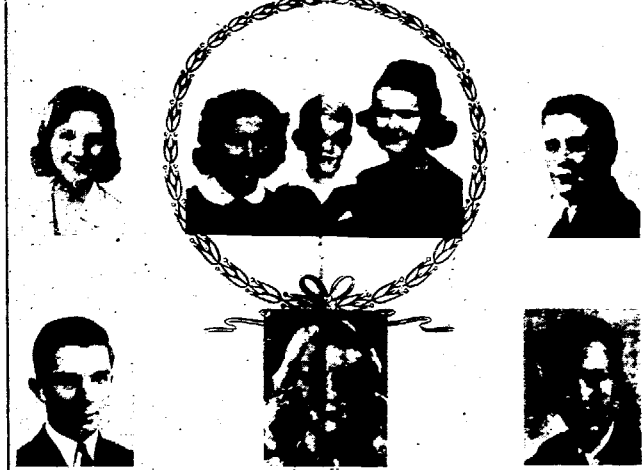
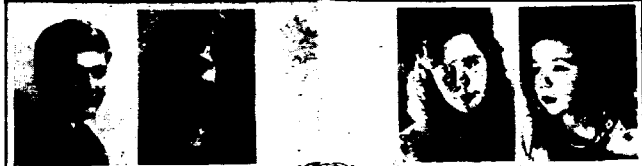

War Chest Success Depends on Women

Pointe's Large Quota. Will Have to be Realized Through Contributions of the Gentler Sex, Chairman Gillis Says

G. W. Gillis, Jr. and Mrs. Edward C. Parker, co-chairmen of the Grosse Pointe War Chest campaign, express great encouragement with the response so far encountered by the solicitors. In many cases subscriptions which were large last year have been substantially increased.

The aim to be raised in the whole area this year is practically double that previously asked for the Community Fund. The total objective for the Detroit area is \$2,800,000 to be divided between the War charities (51%) and the old claimants on the Community Fund (49%).

Here in the Grosse Pointe district the original quota fixed by the general committee in Detroit, through some obvious error, was so small as to excite a query from the local committee. On discussing the matter the Detroit committee advanced the quota to a figure which may have been correspondingly too high.

The local committee does not care to announce this last named quota and feels that if the generous response of the people here is maintained it is possible to reach the high goal.

Many worthy men living here in the Pointe make their contributions to the War Chest through their business affiliations in Detroit, which goes to the credit of the big City and inversely cuts down the contributions which would otherwise be credited to the Pointe if credit went by residence.

The actual solicitation started here on Monday, Nov. 2, and will definitely stop on November 12. There are 400 volunteer solicitors at work in the Pointe area.

RECIPES
Sausage Casserole
4 large sweet potatoes (washed)
1 pork sausage meat
4 large apples
Salt
Water
Brown sugar

METHOD: Peel potatoes, cut into thin slices and place half in bottom of greased casserole, cover with sausage meat, then with sliced apples and pepper and salt over this water until "mashed" and serve at once. Serves 4.

Corned Beef Hollandaise
METHOD: Take 1 can of corned beef. Remove from can, season with salt, pepper and cream juice to taste. Form the meat into patties and top with a slice of hollandaise. Serves 4.

Hotdish Sauce
METHOD: 3 tablespoons of butter in a sauce pan. Remove from heat and add 4 tablespoons of thick cream, 2 egg yolks and the juice of 1 small lemon or 1/2 large lemon. Season to taste with salt and pepper and stir over this water until "mashed" and serve at once. Serves 4.

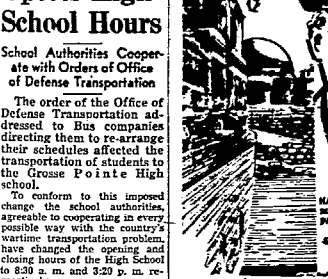
