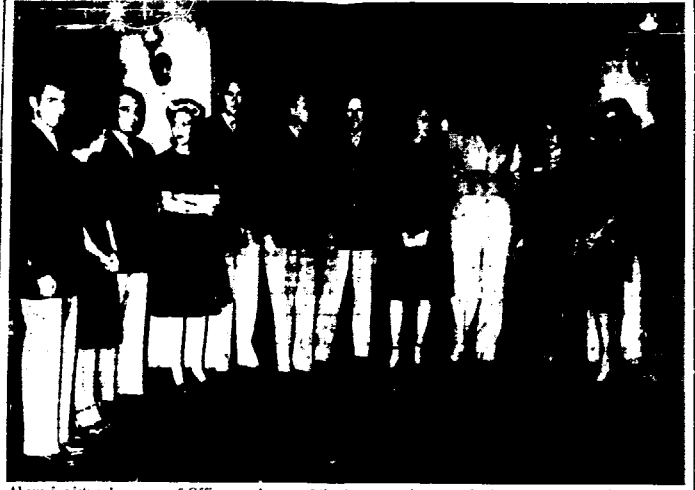

## Officer in Free French Army Hears Good News While Here

Lieut. de Montaudouin Expresses Confidence His Country Will Rise Again; Praises Local Glamour Girls

A distinguished visitor spent last weekend in the Pointe, and his presence had added significance because of the extraordinarily good news coming from the second front in French North Africa at just that time.

He is Lieut. Jacques de Montaudouin, who wears the uniform of an officer of the Colonial Artillery of the Free French Army, and who is on his way to take up the duties of a liaison officer in New Caledonia.

"The News dispatched a reporter to the home of the children of the Montaudouins of New Orleans place, his hosts to interview Lieutenant de Montaudouin and hear what he had to say about the brand new war news. But let him talk for himself—

"It will always remain in my memory that it was in Grosse Pointe that I learned of the first big allied success of the war, and the start of a new phase, the victorious phase. My country has been in the shadow for more than two years now . . . but you know there is something coming out of the shadow . . . before taking a big step it's in the shadow that one retires and thence, it's in the shadow that one retires and prays.

"Certainly France paid and has paid dearly for the mistakes but did she make more mistakes than any other country? I personally think she paid dearly for the honor of fighting the first hour, the first-line battle for Democracy . . .

Recalls Poem "She has been beaten, badly beaten, but not killed. Let me quote those lines from your big American writer, H. L. Phillips, penned just after the fall of France in June 1940— "France is like a rhinoceros. Can a gun ever kill rhinoceros? Can a bullet ever kill rhinoceros? 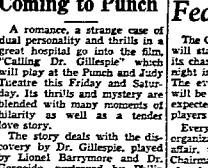

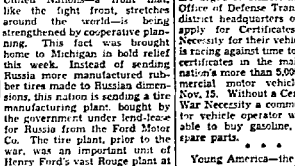
