The Rev. Dr. Theodore V. Moldenke of Hempstead, N. Y., has accepted the call of Eastchester Presbyterian church to become its new pastor. He will be installed on Feb. 25 at 7:30 p. m. Dr. Moldenke has had a wide and varied experience before his call to Eastchester. For three years he was a foreign mission secretary stationed at Rajahmundry, India. After returning to the United States because of his wife's health he became a national missionary founding six churches in unchurched areas in and about New York City.

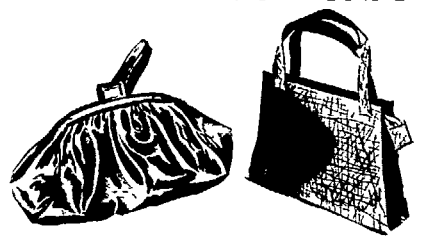
