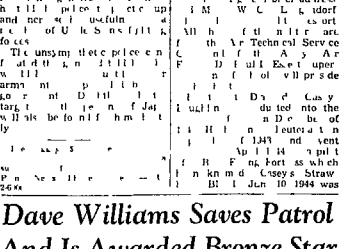

Weeks it may later be decided to ease up in the rigor of the draft program. It is surmised that the present procedure was decided upon about the time of the threatening German drive that began on December 16 on the western front.

**Early Induction**  
But as the situation in respect to service now stands ever male in the designated age group had best make his arrangements for early induction into the army or navy.

Another guess on the draft situation is that in the event of the sudden collapse of organized opposition in Europe tremendous pressure will be exerted both on our soldiers in Europe and the civilian population here at home for an early release from service or at least a good discharge back home.

It may be that in anticipation of it is the authors etc are building up a reserve placement force for the considerable bodies of the military that will have to be kept in Europe for an indefinite period and for the war it may yet have to be carried on for a long time in Asia.

**Another Guess**  
Still another guess is that the Government assembly of the military as a part of our permanent or national defense policy and that to offset the inevitable hue and cry that will go up from millions of mothers and fathers and to women in general that it is not doing so well for a soldier it has been decided to ease the national mind of gradual acceptance of its policy by placing a vast body of young men in the military in addition to all this the grave fact also exists that our casualties in the fighting forces from the physical collapse of those who are in the fighting forces has been very great and large replacements must be provided for on a continuing basis until the war has completely ceased throughout the world.

**Weighty Evidence**  
Another reasonable speculation is that when the tremendous post war armament race is in the making and the power politics so popularly depicted in this country but which nevertheless always exist, make their parade across the world's council tables Uncle Sam may be able to exploit for the view of nations and peoples who respect only power and military might a force in being that will be a bright and shining sword which will add strength and authority to any opinions he may desire to set forth in these deliberations.

All of these possibilities may be segments in the mosaic of war that create and affect the pattern of our future life which concerns every American home. It may even be the inner story of the taking of more than a million young men for combat service in these last reaches of the war out of the homes in this small community.

# Public Schools Plan VE Day Observance By Pointe Students

### Day Will Be Used to Recognize Magnitude of Job Ahead in Defeating Japs Will Honor Men Doing Overseas Fighting

According to Dr. Paul L. Esbert, Superintendent of Schools, principals of all the public schools have now submitted plans for the observance of V E Day in the schools if and when such a day would occur.

While the superintendent recognizes that the war is not over, he is now speculating on the possibility that there will be no such day in the way of an abrupt conclusion of the war in Europe. The schools have felt that at some time possibly in the spring there may come such an occasion when the schools should pause in their work to pay tribute to those who have made and are making victory possible.

Secondly, the day should be used to recognize the magnitude of the job ahead in the war in the Pacific and to rededicate ourselves to the war and its peace, which is the goal.

Accordingly every school will carry on some appropriate program for this occasion. The students of the schools will be called into assembly some of them will spend part of their classroom period in writing letters of gratitude and appreciation to men in service and to military authorities for the successful conclusion of the war in Europe, and others will arrange other most effective of dedicating the minds and hearts and spirits of the children to carry on their part in the war against the Japanese.

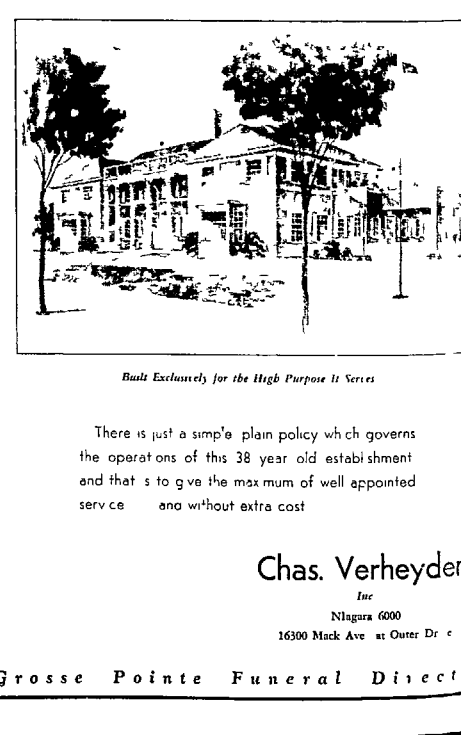

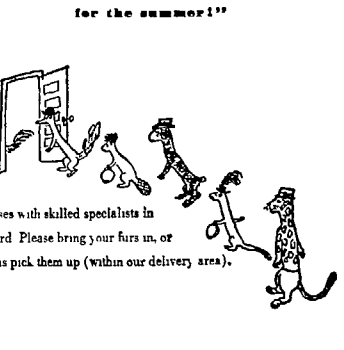

## Coast Guard Plays Big Part In Making Lake Travel Safe

With the opening of the 1945 navigation season near at hand, the Coast Guard headquarters in Cleveland which controls that service activities on the Great Lakes is extending every facility to vessel operators.

Icebreakers are poised to clear the way for the first cargo ships. Buoytenders are prepared to place more than 1,700 aids to navigation in operating order. Marine inspection officers are inspecting and certifying more than 400 vessels.

Lighthouses are being recommissioned. Lighted stations have placed their craft in the water and are standing by to render assistance.

The Coast Guard has been in the thick of every major war effort but its duties on the beach heads have not been performed at the expense of traditional peacetime functions—serving waterborne commerce by fostering safety of life and property at sea.

**34,000 Aids**  
The Coast Guard now maintains more than 34,000 aids to marine navigation along the 11,000 miles of seasonal navigable waters of the Great Lakes and certain territorial waters. These markers and guides mariners are able to determine at all times their exact position on the return to the land and hidden dangers.

Buoys along the Great Lakes range in size from a few 100 deep ponds to the giant 25-foot pound light buoy marking Watery Shoal near Buffalo.
