July Fourth ... A World Study

When the representatives of two and one half million English colonists who were cattered in a thin ribbon of settlements along the Atlantic seaboard declared their political independence of the mother country one hundred and axity nine years ago they proclaimed it in a document which, as a comprehensive yet simple statement of basic human rights, has never been surpassed in the whole story of the human race

of the human race. The constitution subsequently adopted to implement its principles in Government has been expanded, amended and subjected to varying constructions by the Supreme Court, its established interpreter, but the broad basis of human rights which the Declaration set forth has never been questioned or debated.

The one hundred and forty million heirs of that great trument accepted it as unreaservedly today as did its or-ual signers

instrument accepted it as unresservedly today as did its orlightal significance that year of the anniversary of the
signing of this great declaration of social and political pincipulae carries a significance to the whole world little
offeramed at the time by its authors

At this mement fifty nations, including all of the remelling great powers are in process of adopting a charterof world enverage which brings within the hope and vision
of every people, great and small, the attainment of the
identical objectives of the American Declaration.

The greatest siep taken towards this goal is in the unanimous agreement of all nations that war is to be abolished.
With this gained no dream of human betterment is
unjustified

The bold declarations of the American document
permeated the consciousness of the entire delegation at the
united Nations World Security Conference. In certain
specific aspects the prospects for success for the world orgainzation are brighter now than those we faced 169 years
ago We had yet to tight and win a war alone against one
of the worlds most powerful nations Now the overwhelming matural strength of the world is marshalled to protect
each and all against the occurrence of war.

Most of its principles need be only slightly paraphrased
to apply completely to the spiritual thought of The World
Conference

"We had these truths to be self condent that all men.

are created equal that they are endowed by their Creator
with critain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life,
Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.

San Francisco thought the same

among men deriving their just powers from the consent of the governue. San Francisco adopted a world charter to guarantee safety and involobility to every sovereign state large or small, and assure it immunity against unterference in work-ing out its own internal problems

While the Atlantic Charter was not incorporated in the new world convention the freedoms from want fear, speech and worship were indelibly imprinted on the minds of the whole convention and there was an ever present conscious-ness that these should evolve from the foundations there lad

In these smouth evoire from the foundations there Iad his one hundred and sixty ninth anniversary of our independence should be accompanied with a deep sense of moral obligation and responsibility. Our great political document has become in substance a guide and light for the emancipation of peoples throughout the world that have repression through their entire history.

Never before has America s military and industrial mights of lilled the eyes of mankind. Henceforth it must be her must not demonstrate to a longing world corresponding capacities for leadership in the healing of the wounds of the spirit.

She threatened to fight any soldier of the allies who dared to put foot on Free State soil and this included the American soldiers in the north of Ireland whose mission there was to protect freedom including that of the Free State

Had it not been for the hundreds of thousands of men of Had it not been for the hundreds of thousands of men of Irish blood who filled the fighting ranks of the Allies in every corner of the world particularly in the American forces the Free State would now probably be reckoned as a member of the German dominated axis. Her offending was infinitely greater than that of the far distant Argentine, against which we have engendered such a furor of resent-ment.






