

Pointes' School Children Swarm Back to Classes

Early estimates of attendance in the Grosse Pointe public schools yesterday, indicates that approximately 5,000 students are enrolled. L. M. Excerpts from the address of Dr. Paul L. Essert, new superintendent of Grosse Pointe's public school system, to the employees of the system in the high school building Tuesday morning, follow:

OPM Officials Eyering Rails Buried Here

Proposal to Remove Old Steel Imbedded in Pavement of City and Farms

A proposal by the OPM and WPA to remove abandoned street car rails imbedded in part of Jefferson avenue and Grosse Pointe boulevard was revealed recently to Norbert Neff, Chief Clerk of Grosse Pointe City, by Harry Cohen, WPA Engineer.

The plan being to take out the rails and steel sections of the OPM and WPA would authorize WPA state directors to remove abandoned street car rails in city streets under a special arrangement with the city authorities.

The cost of both the removal of the rails and the reconstruction of the pavement would be borne by the WPA. Cohen told Neff in a conversation. Cohen also explained that while the plan was still in the early stages, city officials would receive further explanation of the WPA work later.

The Grosse Pointe city council was informed by Mr. Neff of the WPA request but approval was delayed until more information is submitted by Cohen.

In 1913 the Detroit United Railways constructed a street car railway through Grosse Pointe Park, City and Farms. In 1923 the company ceased operation and the rails were left uncovered in the streets. Since that time the rails on Jefferson avenue through Grosse Pointe City and Grosse Pointe boulevard in the Farms have been left in place.

"I believe," Mr. Neff told the News, "that the removal of the rails would not hurt the pavement in our village. Tearing up Jefferson avenue for the rails would be an expensive job."

Mr. Neff explained that the rails in the Farms are imbedded so deeply that taking them up would almost be an impossible job unless the concrete under the rails was broken. The village of Grosse Pointe Park, City and Farms has not yet been approached by the WPA.

Jumps Amounts to 11 Per Cent of Total Population of May 1940; Additional Statistics Be Released in School Report

The population of the five Grosse Pointe municipalities increased a little more than 11 per cent between May 1940 and May 1941, a survey made by the Grosse Pointe News revealed this week.

Grosse Pointe's School Board figures for 1941, not yet officially released, show the total Pointe population at 23,512. In 1940 the Grosse Pointe population was 20,885—2,632 persons less than for the present year.

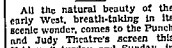
