#### Our School Problem

On Tuesday, September 30, the citizens of Grosse Pointe will vote upon the question of a bond issue of \$150,000, the proceeds to be spent on an addition to the Mason School in the Woods village. This matter comes up for citizen approval because of the phenomenal growth in population of the Woods community with the corresponding increase in school enrollment. The 1400 persons who claimed the Woods area as their home as recently as 1938 had grown to 4300 this year, or a growth of more than 300 per cent. The school enrollment in June of these years had jumped from 252 to 581.
