Most Homes Have Materials Suitable for Blackouts

While no general practice blackouts in the Detroit area have been publicly announced, stores are receiving an increasing number of queries as to proper methods and materials, Charles E. Boyd, secretary of the Detroit Retail Merchants Association, announced. In most cases suitable materials now in the home will meet requirements for a temporary blackout. Mr. Boyd said, adding that the rule to buy materials for this purpose on the two coasts has been turned upon by the Office of Production Management.

Save Everything Possible "In a special message to various retailing organizations," said Mr. Boyd, "OPM asserts that the housewife who makes use of waste material and other substitutes in lieu of buying new materials will be doing a patriotic act, because everything possible should be saved to win the war." While black material is preferred because it is light-absorbent, materials of other shades will also suffice provided they are sufficiently dense or are used in sufficient thickness, according to Mr. Boyd. "If a test blackout should be ordered here," he stated, "most people will be able to cover windows and glass doors with available cloths such as blankets, quilts, bedspreads, carpets, rugs, draperies even overcoats. Heavy paper and cardboard may also suffice.

Test Is Evolved "While no standard test of the light-resistant properties of black-out materials has yet been evolved, a test used by a large New York organization consists in placing a cabinet or box containing a 200-watt master bulb inside a dark room. The test material is then held tightly against the open end of the cabinet. If no light shows through at a distance of nine feet, the material is rated light-proof.

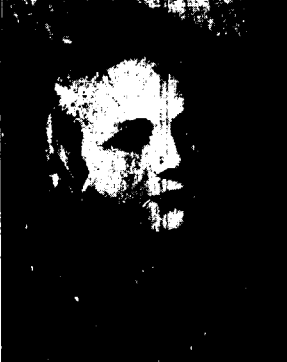
