



### Twenty-Four Years Ago

Twenty four years ago we celebrated our last war time New Year's day. We had been at war with the Central Powers, meaning Germany and Austro-Hungary, since the preceding April. We had had a draft law in force since the preceding May. We had built great cantonments and were drilling several hundred thousand men. Nevertheless we still nursed the hope that we would be called on for only a token representation of men on the actual fighting line.

It was not until one week after New Year's day that President Wilson, heartsick and wearied with the futility of trying to settle the war in Europe by persuasion and concilisation, appeared before a joint session of the Con-gress and made the spaceh "Heard "Round the World" as certainly as the rifle shot at Concord bridge.

gress and made the speech "reard" Adout in the World" as certainly as the rifle shot at Concord bridge.

The gist of President Wilson's speech was that after all sincere effort at composition of the world's difficulties he had discovered at last that the German military mind understood only the language of force and that henceforth that from now on America would step her war effort to that pace and prosecute it "without stint or limit." That was the day that we actually entered the war, despite our highsounding declaration of nine months earlier.

Today, thanks to a better understanding of the situation earned by watching Hiller's eight years of proparation and the clear vision of a President who had accurately appraised the trend, we have an incalculable advantage in having made preparation "without stint or limit" for a full year prior to our actual entry into war. We need every grain of advantage this gives us, for our peril is infinitely greater.

The war of a quarter century ago was fought to "Make the World Safe for Democracy" and, despite the moronic filippancy with which the phrase has been bandied in the Intervening years it was true then and is more terribly true today. The fact that it was not made safe is considered to the war weariness and cowardies of the property o


