He filled the civil lists with litera by millions of particians and placed more millions in a position of fancied obligation to him by way of the dole and various forms of work relief. They are the coulition that elected him in 1940.

Now with the ice thoroughly broken it requires no great courage on his part to essay a fourth term. If he should be elected this time and retain reasonable health for the next few years doubtless another emergency could be maneuver ed four years hence which would again make it necessary for him to be a good solder and run a fifth time.


