Citizens of the Park and Grosse Pointe City are asking the cause of the delay in putting into effect the arrangement for the pooling of the fire apparatus and paid personnel of the wo municipalities to give better fire protection to each

A long time ago the two adjoining municipalities signed an agreement It went so far as to string a wire line between the two departments. The arrangement is simple complete and workable It does not contemplate the expenditure of a single extra dollar. The two places together probably cover less than three square mile and can be adequately served by the two firehouses. 


