At this hearing the Village Commission will decide, upon the expression of your opinion, as to whether or not the zoning ordinance should be amended to allow construction of a theatre and to provide adequate off-street parking facilities. If the decision is favorable, this theatre would then be erected along with the shopping center which our zoning ordinance already permits and the development will be located at the southerly limits of the Village, on Mack avenue, near Seven Mile Road.

The present shopping facilities of this Village are very inadequate and we are in need of more stores to properly service the community. Numerous public improvements could be made in the Village but the Village does not have sufficient assessed valuation to be able to bond for these improvements and this development would tend to alleviate this condition. We need another school in Grosse Pointe Woods and the taxation from this development should hasten its erection as both the land and personal property will be taxed without increasing our present school enrollment and school expense. The development will not materially increase the services now rendered by the Village and Township. There will be a tier of undeveloped lots and one city block between the proposed project and the nearest of eight houses on the nearest street, and the character of this undeveloped and unrestricted tract of land within the Village limits will be established.

This project would be of great convenience to every resident of the Village, and why should we not allow the developers to provide parking on their own land, rather than have parking on all the streets of the Village.

Come to this meeting and express your opinion in order that our Village Commission may make its decision.

Recently there has been a revival of the agitation for a consolidation of all the Pointe municipalities into a single functioning municipal unit. The proposal has been the subject of intermittent discussions for a long time. There are good arguments for and against the proposal in general it might be an appropriate time to revive it again with the cent defeat of the County Home Rule constitutional amend ment whin removes the threat of the absorption of any of the functions of small local governments within the County by a great overlying electly kint County administration.

In favor of the creation of a single Grosse Pointe government may be advanced the advantages of a single administration of its police and fire departments and its other minimiser in the sound of the control of the c

me smailest practicable unit
Doubtless also there are many employes and officials who






