### The New Year

It was not a Merry Christmas and it will not be a 'Happy New Year The trage occurrences on the European front and the added anxiety in the hearts of millions of American fathers and mothers have so shocked the national pride and disrupted the crawfull attempt at composers to countiess American homes at to regardle any fittle gettures at either merchant or real happiness.

There is one customary accompaniment of the New Year Season however which can be observed this year and should be, with greater earnestness and sincerity than ever before

Certain resolutions should be made and kept with an abiding fervor and remembrance

We should resolve to retain our perspective of our true place in this war and with our feet on the ground and our minds clear not be driven to uninformed criticism of those we believe have been responsible for the tragic turn of events in Europe We know too little of what has been going on to advance opinions which might later prove to be harmful and crielly unjust.

But chiefly the civilian here at home who ordinarily makes offerings to his conscience by pliffing resolves which concern little more than his personal habits should this year give pledges to his conscience and his country by his solemn promise that he will henceforth do more and better than he has done heretofore to help his country win this war

If 80 000 000 adult Americans would on this New Year's y consecrate themselves to greater sacrifice for their couns good the results would be incalculable

Americans during this war have made no sacrifices remotely comparable to those which persons in other lands have been making for five years Millions have lived on a better scale than they ever lived in all their lives

With millions the sum total of their financial contribu-tions to the war effort has been to buy, from their ample cash surplus the securities of their go "nment which con-stitute the best form of investment ava sable in the wnole world.

They have given outright to war charities like the Red Cross and to home social services such as the various com-munity funds, with reasonable generosity, but in few if any instances to a degree which has meant actual sacrifice

What every patriotic American should resolve to do this v Year, and continue to do as long as the war lasts is —

To buy bonds and give to war charities to the real limit of his ability,

To refuse absolutely to patronize all black market enter-uses and so make a direct contribution to the fight against flation and for the equal and just distribution of the things eded by all of the people for living

To prevent waste in every form in the conduct of his home and in the use of his individual transportation facilities

To cooperate honestly and wholly with all of the directs of the Government, in the field of conservation and vice, or in any other direction later indicated.

To resolve that his or her contributions to the war effort shall be as real and worthwhile as possible and not gloss over mere social diversion under a thin veneer of morale building

To oppose for himself or his associates the practice of making unusual profits in war production out of the nations

And finally those men and women who work in war production should determine at this New Year of their country speril that they will under no circumstances short of their personal physical disabilities, cease for a moment from their vitally needed work.

These men and women are the front line soldiers of the me front Without that loyalty to country which super les all other directive authority in their work this country

In time of war there can be no divided allegiance be-tween their country and any other authority. It must be the ountry, first and always

### The Criticism of Our Allies

There is a growing disposition on this side of the water to criticize our allies Britain and Russia Not only is this ill timed when we are united in a great military effort to defeat a comno foe but it is inconsistent in a marked decewhen laid alongside our own record of more than a century mast

we criticize the British moves in Greece and in Italy We are not pleased with Rus.as evident purpose to main tain its primacy in the Balkan states although at the moment we can do little about it Russas a determination to take back that part of Poland which was formerly incorporated in the Russian state for a century and a half its displeasing to Americans who hark back to President Wilsons effective efforts to recreate the ancient Polish state and are chafed at the negation of his work.

It is high time for the American people to rearrange their thinking on the post war political and economic com-positions on a basis of realism and consistency and less on pique and passing impulse

interests: A government which failed to do so would have
brief support from its people Britain s life line is trade of
commerce A small country in herself, she has built up a
great empire largely by the peaceful processes of mutually




