Lasting Peace First

Anthony Eden British Foreign Minister, gave some timely advice to the San Francisco delegates when he said they should not attempt too much in almost the same breath however he largely nullified the point of his first remark. He urged they confine themselves cheffly to providing for the establishment of a secure world peace and such economic arrangements as must necessarily be set up as to permit the early resumption of the world's trade and commerce.


